Hy's infectious Smile, Compassion, and zest for life will be deeply missed beyond measure, we love you more than words could ever express, until we meet again.

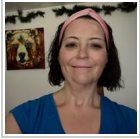

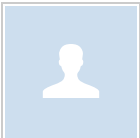
# Tribute Wall

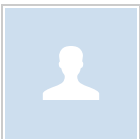

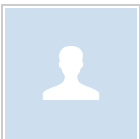
