Cornelis became a US Citizen in 1956 in Los Angeles, California.

He joined the Armed Forces of The United States of America and proudly served his country from April 1958 through April 6, 1961 when he was discharged from the Army in Fort Lewis, Washington.

After the service in the Army Cornelis came back home to Salt Lake City, Utah and met Carol Ann Brake. Later that year they were married in Salt Lake City, Utah at Sacred Heart Catholic Church on 6-17-1961. They were married for 58 years.

Dad and Mom moved to Kearns and bought a home. He was hired at Kennecott Copper Mine (Rio Tinto) where he accepted an apprenticeship to

become a Diesel Mechanic and retired from Rio Tinto.

Dad loved the mountains in Utah and fishing was one of his favorite things to do. Camping, fishing, sharing a great meal with family was what he enjoyed doing most. He also loved the few trips he made to Yellowstone, he loved the geysers and how beautiful it is there.

Cornelis is preceded in death by his parents and 2 sisters.

He is survived by his wife Carole Ann Brake Zwan, Laurie (Mark), Andrew (Jane), Anthony (Sandy), and grandchildren: Brian (Brie), Natalie (Joey), Tyler (Hilly), Nickalus (Amber) Brittanie, Briana, Jacob. Great Grandchildren: Mila, Conner. He is survived by his 5 sisters.
