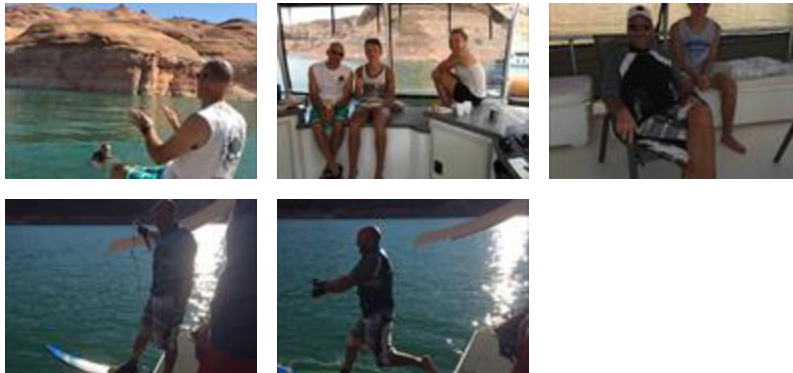

Godspeed my friend, Godspeed.

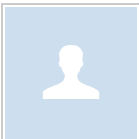
