“ Michael Rivera lit a candle in memory of Mark Duran

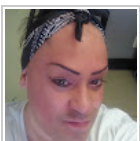

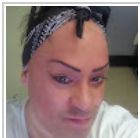

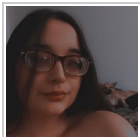
